

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

MEMORIAL GARDEN

OF THE

UNITARIAN UNIVERSALIST CHURCH OF FORT LAUDERDALE

1. Use and Maintenance

The use and maintenance of the Memorial Garden of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale is under the exclusive control of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale and shall be administered through the Board of Trustees of such Church or a Committee designated by such Board. The church will manage and maintain the Garden and its Plaques and keep records so long as the church exists.

No individual shall acquire any right whatsoever with respect to the use or appearance of the Memorial Garden or related memorial plaques or records. The Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale may alter, modify, or relocate the Memorial Garden or any related memorial plaques whenever such changes are required or desirable, in the sole judgment of the Board of Trustees of such church.

2. Rights and Containers

Each applicant for use of the Memorial Garden agrees and understands that ashes will be interred without container or scattered and will not be recoverable or preserved intact. Burial is considered permanent and ashes may not be moved. No applicant or other person may acquire any right in the physical location or appearance of the Memorial Garden. It is understood that a variety of activities and events may occur within the area of the Memorial Garden.

3. Eligibility

The ashes of the following persons are eligible for interment/scattering in the Memorial Garden:

- a member of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale
- a spouse, child, parent, grandparent, grandchild, brother or sister of a member of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale
- any others who the Board of Trustees, or a Committee designated by such Board, shall accept for interment/scattering in the Memorial Garden.

4. Plaques

The names of all persons whose ashes are interred/scattered in the Memorial Garden shall be entered in a Permanent Memorial Book maintained by the Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale. A plaque bearing the name of each person whose ashes are interred/scattered in the Memorial Garden will be erected within the Memorial Garden and will be maintained by the church. The style, design, and maintenance of the plaque will be in accordance with policies and decisions of the Board of Trustees of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale, or a Committee designated by such Board.
