

5. Payment

A payment to the Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale will be required from each applicant for use of the Memorial Garden prior to granting permission to use the Memorial Garden. The amount of such required payment shall be determined from time to time by the Board of Trustees of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale, or a Committee designated by such Board.

Certificates of Memorialization and Burial Rights may be purchased in advance. This certificate guarantees the owner's right to have his/her ashes buried in the Memorial Garden and to be memorialized with a plaque. This certificate is not to be construed as a deed to a specific burial plot. Certificates may be transferred to other members of one's family or redeemed at face value upon written notice to the Board of Trustees of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale.

6. Approvals

No interment/scattering of ashes or memorial service shall be conducted, nor shall any plants, flowers, statuary, or decorations be placed in or about the Memorial Garden without the prior approval of the Board of Trustees of the Unitarian Universalist Church or Fort Lauderdale, or a Committee designated by such Board.

7. Rules and Regulations

The Board of Trustees for the Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale, or a Committee designated by such Board, shall from time to time adopt administrative rules and regulations pertaining to the use, appearance, maintenance, costs, improvement, and perpetuation of the Memorial Garden, memorial plaques, and memorial records.

The following Rules and Regulations are adopted pursuant to Section 7 of the Terms and Conditions of the Use of the Memorial Garden :

1. The payment for use of the Memorial Garden for intermentscattering of ashes of a person described in Section 5 shall be \$250. The Board of Trustees may waive, or change the amount of such payment upon request of the applicant due to hardship or for other sufficient reason.
2. Members may pay in advance to take advantage of current fixed costs.
3. All funds received by the Memorial Garden Committee shall be so recorded by the Treasurer and utilized solely for the purposes pertaining to the Memorial Garden.
4. Upon request of an Applicant for use of the Memorial Garden, the Board of Trustees of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Fort Lauderdale, or its designated Committee, may authorize:
 - memorialization with a plaque within the Memorial Garden in the absence of the interment/scattering of ashes,
 - omission of the decedent's name from the public plaque erected within the Memorial Garden.
